RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF SLIPPERY ROCK COUNCIL, of SLIPPERY ROCK BOROUGH, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENT TO APPLY FOR A GRANT THROUGH PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT'S MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR NEW STREETLIGHTS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, Slippery Rock Borough currently has 50 light poles (streetlights) within the borough that are in a state of disrepair being rusted and corroded to the point where they are now failing; and,

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Community and Economic Development is offering a grant to local municipalities to improve infrastructure within these municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, Slippery Rock Borough has decided to apply for the above-mentioned grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by SLIPPERY ROCK COUNCIL, of SLIPPERY ROCK BOROUGH, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, that it is applying for the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development's Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant in the amount of \$711,828.00 to replace and install 50 streetlights along Main Street, Franklin Street, and New Castle Street, and that Shawn Pugh, Borough Manager be designated as the official to execute all documents related to the application.
