President Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

#### **Outside Entity Reports:**

**Slippery Rock University:** Robb King reported that the University is celebrating Black History Month. There will be more than 20 in-person and virtual events throughout February.

Slippery Rock Community Library: (See Attached) Karen Pierce provided updates for the library for the month of January. President Campbell read the updates aloud. Slippery Rock Parks and Recreation: Mary Messer reported that the Park's Father-Daughter dance is this Friday, February 11<sup>th</sup> at the elementary school. There will be two horse drawn carriages this year. Mary also approached Council regarding her wish to apply for the Local Park Renovation Grant. She would use the grant to add a softball field for the park. The grant is for \$10,000. The park would be responsible for \$2,500 of that total amount.

**Slippery Rock Volunteer Fire Company & Recue Team:** Ron Steele reported that the fire department finalized plans for the new fire truck that will arrive in September of 2022. He also stated that the fish and chicken dinners will start in March for the lent season and will run every Friday from March 4<sup>th</sup> to April 15<sup>th</sup>.

Lastly, he spoke with Sky King Fireworks regarding the Independence Day celebration in 2022. They are on schedule for Saturday July 2<sup>nd</sup> if Council agrees.

#### Citizen Input:

Amber Malborough from 356 W. Cooper Street addressed Council with her concern over the Cold Patch plant that the township plans to build on the corner of Stoughton and New Castle Road. She is concerned with the health consequences due to the pollutants that it may put into the air and water. President Campbell stated that the Borough Manger would inquire more about it but that her best option would be to have the Environmental Protection Agency involved. He added that the plant would be under strict guidelines to ensure public safety.
