

**SLIPPERY ROCK BOROUGH  
PROJECT MEETING MINUTES  
JULY 18, 2017**

Slippery Rock Borough convened this date at the Slippery Rock Borough Building located at 306 East Water Street, Slippery Rock Borough, Butler County, Pennsylvania. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon roll call the following public officials were present: Regina Greenwald, Ken Harris, Ron Steele, Tom McPherson, Steve Saylor and Royce Lorentz. Absent from the meeting was Bob Bowser. Also present were Mayor Ron Fodor and Borough Administrator Lucinda G. Lipko.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

Chief Fedokovitz requested permission to purchase 4 new Tasers for the department. The ones they are using are 10 years old and soon we will not be able to get replacement parts for them. Council agreed to place this on the August 8<sup>th</sup> agenda for action. The Chief also reported that OfferUp, the largest mobile marketplace for local buyers and sellers in the U.S., is requesting we agree to designate a safe transaction site for buyers/sellers of online transactions. This would be at the end of the paved parking lot of the Borough Building.

President Greenwald reviewed the capital improvements planning chart and Council discussed the level of importance of each item. This is an ongoing plan and will help with the budgeting process.

Joe Baechtel was present and requested Council consider vacating a portion of Buckem Alley that runs beside his house which he uses as his driveway (approximately 236 feet) at 622 Cross Street. The back portion is overgrown and has large trees on it. He would like Council to approve this to secure his driveway. He was told that Council will be discussing paper alleys at the meeting scheduled for August 8<sup>th</sup> and the engineer and solicitor will both be present.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

A motion was made by Tom McPherson to advertise for bids and an alternate bid (replace one door with a window) for the Front Landing Repairs to the Borough Building. Seconded by Ken Harris, motion carried.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

A motion was made by Steve Saylor to adjourn. Seconded by Ken Harris, motion carried.
